No deposits or Pre-Orders on tables of up to 6 people.

For group of 6 or more we require a £10 per person deposit. We will also need a menu pre-order 14 days in advance of your booking.

Do you have Private Hire Facilities?

We have a private function room that can accommodate up to 120 people for a seated meal and 150 for informal buffet.

We also have our Snug which is ideal for smaller groups and family gatherings of 8-16 people. The snug is very popular for Sunday Lunch groups so needs to be booked well in advance.
